# The Annual Report of XITE College (2020-21)

#### Academic

After the summer vacation the College reopened, and regular online classes resumed from 15th June 2020. An online group project competition on Entrepreneurship for the 6th Semester BBA class was conducted and the best three projects are uploaded on our website. The new Vice-Chancellor of Kolhan University, Dr Ganghadar Panda visited the College and interacted with the Management on 25th July 2020. The academic results of batch 2017-20 were very encouraging, 100% of the students secured 1st division and one of the BCom students secured silver medal (2nd topper) from the University. One student got admission in IIM Ranchi. Two students got job in BYJU'S.

The Freshers online orientation was conducted from 14th to 16th September 2020 and Dr. L. Jena, XUB and Dr. Madhumita Das, Centurion University were the resource persons. They addressed the students and faculty on "Thirst for Learning and Career Choices" and on "Career Choices in Economics and Higher Education in General" respectively.

### Webinars/Seminars

The College organized several webinars during the year.

A National Webinar on "RTI ACT: The Armour of Democracy" on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and Mr. Deepak Kumar Nirala, Advocate and Pleader Commissioner, Jharkhand High Court was the resource person.

A Webinar on "Social Entrepreneurship: Rejuvenating India through Innovation" was organized on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2020 and the resource person was Dr. Mita Tarafder, Chief Scientist & Head of Knowledge Resource and Information Technology Division CSIR-National Metallurgical Laboratory, Chairperson of Indian Institute of Metals, Jamshedpur.

A national webinar on "New Education Policy 2020: Issues and Implications in Higher Education in Jharkhand" was organized on 26<sup>th</sup> September. On 6<sup>th</sup> February 2021 some of the College Faculty and students at the College attended the Ethics Oration organized by XLRI.

A webinar on "HR Buddy" with Mr. Anand Kumar an HR specialist in the corporate field was conducted on 19th May 2021. He shared his experience and stressed the importance of developing skills along with knowledge for employability.

An online interaction with the parents was conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> May and many parents appreciated the wholehearted effort and support of the College for conducting the online classes during the difficult time.

#### **Awards & Collaborations**

Fr. Dr. E.A. Francis received the Top 30 Dynamic Principal Award (The Golden Aim Award) for Excellence & Leadership in Education from FAMA Global Management Services (ASIA-GCC) on 11<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

The College in collaboration with Relearn Foundation, an NGO of NML submitted a project to the Central Government and after their review, the project was presented on 20th February 2021.

XITE College in collaboration with the JUSCO installed streetlights on the approach road to the Campus.

The College formed a committee for National Innovation and Start-up Policy (NISP) with three external members and had its 1st meeting on 30th January 2021 at XLRI.

A two-month Special English coaching classes for the local youth and for the weak students at the College was organized from 1<sup>st</sup> February to March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021, and altogether 30 people (20 +10) benefitted from it.

The College has signed a MoU with CSSPL on 15th December 2020 for the upskilling the College students.
